Admission rules (2023-2024)

1. All candidates seeking admission in B.A. Part 1 and B. Com Part 1 class have to appear in CUET (B.A.) and CUET (B.Com.) test 2023 for admission in B.A. and B. Com. The admissions shall be made on the basis of merit in CUET (B.A.) and CUET (B. Com) entrance test conducted by the University of Allahabad.
2. Admission will be done on the basis of merit till the availability of seats.
3. The candidate will be required to present themselves in person for the counseling and admission on the notified date/time and place subject to the order of the government authorities/ university regarding Covid-19.
4. **RESERVATION AND SPECIAL CONSIDERATION / QUOTA**
 - (i) 15% of the total seats for the Scheduled Caste (SC) category, 7.5% of the total seats for Scheduled Tribe (ST) category, 27% of the total seats for Other Backward Caste (OBC) category shall be reserved for candidates belonging to these category, all certificates are on the central Government format.
 - (ii) 10% of the total seats shall be reserved for candidate belonging to EWS category.
5. **Sports Quota-** 2% of the total seats in shall be allotted under Sports Quota.
6. Admission under separate quota will strictly be on the basis of merit list provided by the advisory committee, Sports Board.

7. Person with Disability (Divyang):

5% of total seats for this course will be available for person with disability who can pursue this course without any difficulty. 1% with benchmark disability under clauses (d) and (e) namely:

- a. Blindness and low vision.
- b. Deaf and hard of hearing.
- c. Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular dystrophy.
- d. Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness.
- e. Multiple disabilities from amongst person from clauses (a) to (d).

NCC Weightage:

A weightage of 5% shall be added to the score obtained by the candidate holding NCC 'B' certificate in the Admission Test / Entrance Test.

Documents to be presented at the Time of Admission

1. High-school or equivalent examination mark sheet and certificate in original along with its self-attested photocopy.
2. Intermediate or equivalent examination mark sheet and certificate in original along with its self-attested photocopy.
3. Original Transfer Certificate/Migration Certificate for regular candidates at the Qualifying Examination/ affidavit duly attested by a Notary/Public Commissioner for private candidates at the Qualifying Examination.

4. Admit Card issued by the University.
5. Score Card of CUET .
6. Claiming weightage /premium/special Consideration:
 - i. For SC/ST, OBC and EWS category candidates governed by Rule 1.1, 1.2 and 1.3 :
 - a. For SC/ST category candidates recent caste certificate (original and photocopy)
 - b. For OBC candidates recent Caste certificate on Central Government format indicating Non-creamy layer is a must and any other certificate if required. (original and photocopy)
For EWS candidate, EWS certificate on Central Government format. (original and photocopy)
 - c. For the applicants Kashmiri Migrants category: Original and a photocopy of the certificate issued by competent authority for Kashmiri Migrants.
 - d. For the applicants holding NCC 'B' Certificate: Original and a photocopy of the NCC 'B' certificate.
 - e. For the applicants of Sports quota: Original and photocopy of the certificate in support of outstanding contribution in sports at National Level and State Level. For this the candidate will be interviewed by the Board organized by the Athletic Association at the time and place announced by it.
 - f. For the applicants of Divyang quota: Original and a photocopy of the certificate of Physical Disability (Visual, Hearing, Orthopaedic) issued by the Chief Medical officer of a District Hospital or by the Viklang-Kendra, Prayagraj and to appear before a Board of Doctors to assess the intensity of disability/challenge on a date and place given by the college

- g. Income certificate of the parent/guardian, issued by the competent authority/ officer in case if Annual / Family Income have a consideration for any claim of the candidate.
- h. A copy of online filled anti- ragging certificate will be required at the time of admission.
